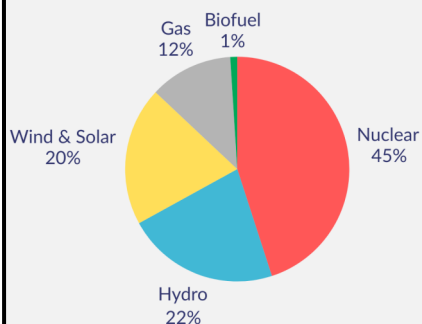

Electricity is made at generating stations across Ontario.

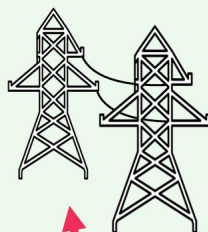
Ontario's power grid provides energy made from...

TRANSMISSION

The electricity travels through high-voltage transmission lines.

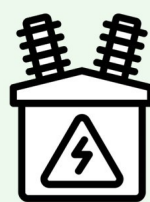


This is Wataynikaneyap Power!



CONVERSION

It reaches a substation, where the voltage is lowered.



DISTRIBUTION

The lower-voltage electricity travels through powerlines to inside your building.

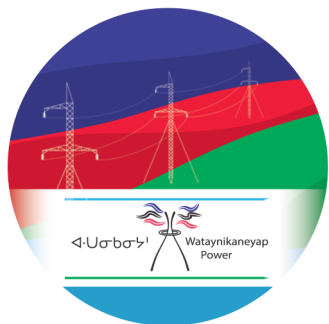
